## SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The Paul William “Bill” Jeffcoat papers were received from Bill Jeffcoat, a photographer and the owner of a local camera shop. Paul Henry Jeffcoat, Bill’s father, was the original owner of the photography studio and camera shop.

Paul Henry Jeffcoat was friends with and attended Abilene High School and Kansas State University with Milton Eisenhower. Paul and Milton were also members of the same fraternity at KSU, Sigma Alpha Epsilon.

Bill Jeffcoat contacted the Eisenhower Library on numerous occasions to make donations to the archives. The holdings in this collection range from 1913 to 1995 and include photographs and negatives, correspondence, diaries and other diverse materials. Bill Jeffcoat also donated writings by Deane W. Malott about Abilene and Eisenhower family history.
