The Medal was founded and perpetuated by the trust fund established by Conrad L. Lauer, Philadelphia. It is held by The American Society of Mechanical Engineers and is administered by the Hoover Medal of Award consisting of representatives of four national societies: The American Society of Chemical Engineers, the American Institute of Mining, Metallurgical and Petroleum Engineers, The American Society of Mechanical Engineers and The American Institute of Electrical Engineers. )
