## SCOPE AND CONTENT

The President's Commission on National Goals was organized in February, 1960 as a non-official body whose purpose was to "develop a broad outline of national objectives and programs for the next decade and longer."<sup>1</sup> It operated under the auspices of the American Assembly (established by President Eisenhower at Columbia University in 1950 as a non-partisan educational organization) and was financed by private sources through the Assembly. The Commission was headed by Dr Henry Wriston—appointed by President Eisenhower on February 3, 1960. The other members of the Commission were Vice Chairman Frank Pace, Erwin D. Canham, James B. Conant, Colgate W. Darden, Jr., Crawford H Greenewalt, Alfred M. Gruenther, Learned Hand, Clark Kerr, James R. Killian, Jr., and George Meany.

Of the numerous topics first visualized, fifteen were defined in the final report of the Commission. A writer was selected for each topic (i.e., goal) and was assisted by an ad hoc panel selected to counsel and criticize. And, as a general rule, one or more members of the Commission participated with each ad hoc panel. The Commissions commented upon, approved or disapproved, the papers being written on the chosen topics.

The completed report of the Commission—respecting President Eisenhower's request that its efforts be non-partisan—was sent to the President on November 16, 1960. <sup>2</sup>The Report was published by Prentice Hall on December 12, 1960 in both paperback and hardbound editions.

The Commission ceased activity with the submission of its report to the President, but its offices remained open until approximately May, 1961, so as to make further arrangements for publicizing the Commission's report through the use of the communications media and the establishment of numerous discussion group.

The records of the President's Commission consist of correspondence (primarily outgoing staff letters), inter-office memos, minutes of panel and Commission meetings, panel, Commission and staff comments on Chapters, author-panel rosters, numerous drafts of chapters and the Commission Report, summaries of chapters, printer's copies and proof sets of chapters, press releases and clippings and 3x5 and 5x8 card files. The records in this file originated in more than one staff member's office, but any one segment cannot be directly attributed to one particular person.
